Dear Council planners,

I am writing to air some significant concerns I have about the above development application.

My wife and I have just agreed, (paid deposit and awaiting completion) on the purchase of 47 Carefree Road. The neighbouring property to No. 45. We have viewed the plans for the additions and extensions to no. 45 online, and although we have not yet lived at number 47 we do have what we feel are some major concerns about the current proposal.

- Firstly, the significant increase in the overall size of the build will have an adverse impact on the light and sunlight that is received down the eastern side of our new house and through the eastern side windows. This is already a dark/damp area of the property at 47, with little grass growth, this will be further acerbated by increased shadows and blocking of light.
- The plans for no. 45 show an increase in height and number of windows on the western side of that property making no. 47 more overlooked and affording us less privacy in our garden.
- The increase in overall height and number of balconies on the front/southern side of the property will also overlook our property and impact our privacy.
- The size of the building overall will mean there is potential for many more people to live at the property with associated greater number of cars and traffic movement than there is at the moment in what is an already congested road with very limited on street parking space. I feel it is already very difficult for fire and ambulance services to access this road as it is without further congestion.
- The limited access via Carefree road for construction materials and removal of building waste will dictate a larger number of truck movements down the roadway during the build impacting on our overall amenity of the area and our home.
- The significant changes from the current property will mean an ongoing and lengthy build process that will impact our family and our amenity of the area and home for many months, if not years, during the build.

Overall, we feel that a build of this magnitude is not commensurate with the size of the available site, the access for construction vehicles the overall street scene and neighbourhood.

Thank you for the opportunity to raise our concerns about this proposal and thank you in advance for your consideration in the above points during your deliberation.
