I object to the proposed extension of working hours on the Harbord Diggers Club Site.

The extension would overlap with weekday evenings between 5-8pm and Saturday afternoon between 1-3pm and conflict with the public use of the Freshwater Headland area. The extended working hours would have a negative impact on the use of the area on weekday evenings, when people finish work and school, and on Saturday afternoons, when many families head to the beach. As local residents, we often visit the Freshwater Headland area in the early evening, and the proposed extension of on-site works would intrude into this time.

The extended work hours would mean extended hours for on-street parking and truck movement associated with the development. The on-street parking of trucks takes up limited road space and can obscure visibility for other road users, including cyclists. Truck movement on weekday evenings and Saturday afternoons would adversely affect the amenity of the area and should be avoided in the interests of safety.

The truck movement associated with the development has been a persistent source of disturbance for months. The noise has disrupted our sleep in the early hours of the morning, well before the time approved for the commencement of works. We believe that local residents deserve some respite during weekday evenings and Saturday afternoons and do not support the application to extend work hours.
