Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- All Development Applications on
- Actual or potential threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats;
- Wildlife corridors;
- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query X type located in both A & C Wards;

And as such, Council's Natural Environment Unit officers are required to consider the likely potential environmental impacts.

Officer comments

The development will not result in significant onsite loss of canopy cover or a net loss in native canopy trees, with only 3 planted small trees less than 5 metres height removed, and two transplanted. The site is not mapped as native vegetation or wildlife corridor.
