

## Summary Report of Public Notification

Project name	Proposed Lease – Beacon Hill Community Kindergarten
Public notification period	Thursday 10 October 2024 – Thursday 7 November 2024
Background	Northern Beaches Council is proposing to grant Beacon Hill Community Kindergarten a 10-year lease to continue their childcare operations at Beacon Hill War Memorial Hall. The land is located at 35 Willandra Road, Beacon Hill also known as Beacon Hill Reserve and Beacon Hill War Memorial Community Centre, Part Lot 7095 DP1069200 and Part Lot 2574 DP752038.
Total number of submissions	1
Summary of findings	One submission was received which was not supportive of the granting of a 10-year lease.
	Concerns were raised around the noise and behaviour from the children, along with the maintenance of the trees which impacted the respondent.
Engagement approach	The notice was provided via post to adjoining properties, on- site signage and a page established on Councils website with a form where online submissions could be made.
	Contact details were provided to allow members of the public to submit enquiries or comments.

Findings		
Theme	What we heard	Council response
Behaviour of the children	The respondent submitted a complaint relating to noise generated by the children at the centre and the throwing of objects by the children into their adjoining property.	Council understands that a properties surrounding a childcare centre may encounter additional noise and activity arising from children playing. Council also recognises and understands the valuable services that childcare offers to the community and will work with the kindergarten to address the concerns raised whilst not impeding the enjoyment and learning of the children. Should there be any further concerns, we encourage these to be raised with the kindergarten as they occur so the any poor behaviour can be rectified in a timely manner. Under Section 70(2) of the Crown Land Management Regulation 2018, Council will renew the lease and grant a 10-year lease to Beacon Hill Community Kindergarten.
Tree maintenance	The respondent showed concern over the trees not being maintained which has resulted in maintenance to the respondents roof.	Council will raise these concerns with the kindergarten to be addressed under the provisions of the lease, noting also that neighbours may prune overhanging branches with the relevant consents.
