This is a massive overdevelopment on such an environmentally sensitive street where the maximum height limit is set at 8 metres and two storey houses.

This proposed development is four storeys! And with a swimming pool on the roof which will create unacceptable noise levels for neighbours. There are no rooftop pools in Bilgo9la Beach and no four storey houses. It will set a precedent if approved.
