Additionally, running groups use the adjacent park on most Sunday mornings.

Secondly, the introduction of a carnival atmosphere including bands & music, as well as the 7.00am set up commencement should not be placed in a passive residential environment.

Lastly, our local Council has a Planning Dept. that has delineated separate zones for Residential and Retail/Commercial uses. Why would our Council even entertain the thought of permitting a loud, crowded Market/Fair right in the middle of this passive residential area.

We trust that commonsense prevails and that this proposal is refused, and that Council continue to focus on promoting activity within the Freshwater Village Shopping Centre.
