Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- All Development Applications on
- Actual or potential threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats;
- Wildlife corridors;
- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query X type located in both A & C Wards;

And as such, Council's Natural Environment Unit officers are required to consider the likely potential environmental impacts.

Officer comments

The proposal to install a rainwater tank, including native landscaping has been assessed against the objectives and requirements of WLEP 2000. The location of the new water tank is on managed land and therefore has no impact on the natural landscape. Furthermore, indigenous native plants will be grown on the mound in front of the tank thus enhancing the natural landscape.

The proposed development is unlikely to have a significant impact to the environment, and will retain distinctive environmental features, protect existing flora and will protect Koala habitat.

The proposal is therefore supported.
