Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent for the following:

Officer comments

The modification application seeks to further refine the building design to enhance amenity and improve buildability. The landscape modifications include an amended ground floor planter layout along Commonwealth Parade as shown in the architectural plans and other minor adjustments.

The landscape component of the modification proposal is acceptable subject to the issue of amended landscape plans to co-ordinate with the architectural plans and the continuation of the landscape conditions under Mod2018/0575, being ANS17- On slab planter works and planting; ANS18- Landscape works, as modified by the amended landscape plans; ANS19- Landscape Maintenance; and ANS20- Environmental and priority weed control.

Council's Landscape Referral section have assessed the application against the landscape controls of Manly DCP 2013, section 3: General Principles of Development, and section 4: Development Controls and Development Types.

The proposal is therefore supported.
