If the tree in question is within 2m of the footings of the premises it would be considered exempt from requiring a Council permit for removal.

As stated in the above link a tree can be removed without a permit if it is 'placed where the base of the trunk of the tree at ground level, is located within two metres of an existing approved building (not including decks, pergolas, sheds, patios or the like, even if they are attached to a building)'.
