2.2 EXEMPTIONS

Council consent is not required for removal if the tree is less than 6 metres in height, the tree is dead, a noxious weed, is referred to in the list of exempt species in Appendix 5 of the WDCP 2011, or is considered dangerous to life or property. Note: A tree less than 6 metres in height which has a canopy width exceeding 7 metres will require consent. (For properties within Deferred Lands under the WLEP 2000 then you must consider the Tree Preservation Order). Trees which are considered a high risk/imminent danger to life and property by a Level 5 qualified Arborist are exempt development and can be removed without Council consent by the owner of the tree.

You need written confirmation from the Arborist and the report must clearly state the following:

- Qualifications: AQF Level 5 Arborist or equivalent (see WDCP 2011, Part H, Appendix 10)
- The tree(s) is declared a 'high risk' or is an imminent danger to life and property
- Immediate removal of the tree(s) is recommended

A copy of the report is to be sent to council for record keeping purposes.

You may also prune a tree by less than 10% of the foliage within a 12 month period without Council consent.

2.4 OWNERS CONSENT

The owner of the land on which the tree(s) are located must sign the consent on the application.
