Feedback on Application number DA2020/1179

This letter is in reference to the proposed development on 1793 Pittwater Road, Mona Vale, to add 6 additional 3 bedroom townhouses which is expanded from the previously approved development in the three blocks adjoining this (1795 & 1797 Pittwater Road and 38 Park Street)).

I have some concerns that I would like addressed before giving official approval:

- The DA number as stated above still states the original 16 townhomes. It does not communicate the new additional 6 townhomes
- As such, there should be a new DA for the whole project as the scope and therefore, the impact on the surrounding streets have changed
- 22 townhomes is considerably more than any other development in the local area. The townhome complex in 44-48 Park Street only has 8 townhomes on previously three large blocks as a comparison
- Garbage collection will be an issue with the increase number of bins going from 3 to 22. This issue does not seem to be addressed. Where will the extra bins go? How will it impact traffic in what is already a busy and congested corner? Is it an accident hazard?
- What is the timeline for this construction? Park Street is already a
 nightmare for traffic. The recently completely NDIS Centre in 35 Park
 Street caused a lot of problems in traffic and road access and this was a
 small one building single level development. Is there a traffic plan for
 vehicle access etc?
- This has an impact especially in the morning before and afternoon after school with a combined total of nearly 1800 school students from Mona Vale Public and Sacred Heart Schools already causing congestion with parents driving and a multitude of school buses
- Also, large trucks that regularly go through theis corner street to service the Woolworths centre

- Will there be plans to have traffic lights at the corner of Park Street and Pittwater Road to manage this new increase in traffic? This is a very dangerous corner that council has yet to fix after years of community feedback.
- Will there be multiple pedestrian crossings and introduction of a 40km/hour school zones in Park Street to address this increase in traffic and therefore the safety of school students and parents? Is it already a nightmare to cross the road for kids.
