#### Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent for development upon unsewered land.

And as such, Council's Environmental Health and Protection officers are required to consider the likely impacts.

## Officer comments General Comments

This application is seeking consent for the construction of the following:

Area 1: hardstand parking area, access pathway, enlarged deck around swimming pool, and landscaping,

Area 2: kitchen garden with raised planters, garden shed, rainwater tank, pergola and greenhouse,

Area 3: covered verandah and entrance walkway,

Area 4: stormwater infrastructure

Based on a review of the Statement of Environmental Effects and having spoken to Northern Beaches Planning, the proposed kitchen garden area with the shed and greenhouse will not have any sinks or toilets installed or other means of generating wastewater that would need to go to the existing wastewater system. There is an existing wastewater system onsite treating the main dwelling. This approval to operate has expired, Environmental Health recommends approval subject to conditions.

The proposal is therefore supported.
