Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- Actual or potential threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats;
- Wildlife corridors;
- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query X type located in both A & C Wards;

And as such, Council's Natural Environment Unit officers are required to consider the likely potential environmental impacts.

Officer comments

The development has been assessed against cl 7.6 Biodiversity of Pittwater LEP 2014 and clause 13 Development on land within the coastal environment area of the State Environmental Planning Policy (Coastal Management) 2018.

The development satisfies the controls as it is designed, sited and will be managed to avoid any significant adverse environmental impact, and will not impact the integrity and resilience of the ecological environment, including native vegetation and fauna and their habitats.
