CONDITIONS THAT MUST BE ADDRESSED PRIOR TO ANY COMMENCEMENT

Tree and vegetation protection

- (a) Existing trees and vegetation which must be retained
- i) All trees and vegetation not indicated for removal on the approved plans, unless exempt under relevant planning instruments or legislation
 - ii) Trees and vegetation located on adjoining land
- (b) Tree and vegetation protection
 - i) No roots greater than 25mm diameter are to be cut from protected trees unless authorised by a qualified Arborist on site.
 - ii) All structures are to bridge roots greater than 25mm diameter unless directed otherwise by a qualified Arborist on site.
 - iii) All tree protection to be in accordance with AS4970-2009 Protection of trees on development sites, with particular reference to Section 4 Tree Protection Measures.

- iv) All pruning within the subject site is to be in accordance with relevant local planning controls and AS 4373 Pruning of amenity trees
- v) All tree and vegetation protection measures, including fencing, are to be in place prior to commencement of works.
