Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the DA 2019/1234 which is proposing to increase the patronage of the current restaurants on Manly Wharf. Having been a resident in the Manly region since 1972 it has been disappointing to see the heritage value and living amenities of the Manly Region being down graded to a alcohol

My understanding is that IF this DA is approved it could result in over 2,500 people being crammed into a relatively small area which could be a recipe for a breakdown in social order.
