As this is a prefabricated all metal structure, waste and rubbish will be limited to plastic packaging, cardboard and a small amount of metal off- cuts that will amount to approximately 0.9m³. There will be approximately 1m³ of timber handrail that will demolished off the existing balcony. This will amount to less than a utility load of waste.

Thereby the above will be removed to our bin system at our factory unit in Brookvale, where it will be separated into the appropriate rubbish and/ or recyclable material waste and disposed of in appropriate ways to an approved tip or waste transfer station.

Where there is mixed waste it will be stacked in the storage area on site, off site it will be taken to Kimbriki tip at Mona Vale and or to the closest landfill.
