I am unclear as to whether another teaching/community space is to be built Obviously I would like to see a space where I could continue my twice weekly classes but I fear that once the demolition occurs and we have a forced extended break, our groups of ladies from Garden Shed Mosaics will be dispersed permanently

I guess I'm asking for 2 things: 1. is there any way a demountable classroom could be set up in the far corner of the carpark during demolition/construction, so our weekly classes can continue? I am under the impression that the site will remain open for trade, so remaining open for my classes would be wonderful!

2. will there be a new classroom located in the redevelopment that will serve as a creative/community space that I could use once the redevelopment has been completed?
