My major objections are:

- Destruction of a key heritage building in the Manly Conservation Area
- Exceeds height limits
- . Excavation works under the heritage site could that will impact footings and structure of all surrounding buildings.
- . Exceeds FSR
- . Massive loss of amenity to adjacent buildings at rear of property, in particular Pacific Waves.
- . View loss for multiple properties and reduction in unit values.
- . Cranes and truck movements proposed for Henrietta Lane, an already extremely busy thoroughfare, would be untenable.
