i wish to object strongly to the approval of this application on the following grounds:

1) amenity - the back fenceline of this block is on Allenby Park Rd, Allambie Heights, a quiet residential area. Currently the only barrier from the pollution and noise of the Brookvale industrial area is the bushland corridor of which this block of land forms part. Clearing and development of this land will severely impinge on the amenity of the eastern residential side of Allambie heights.

2) environmental impact - this block forms part of an ever-decreasing but essential wildlife corridor on the northern beaches. My property backs onto Allenby Park Reserve and I have photographic evidence of the wildlife which uses this bushland. There is at least one pair of powerful owls who breed in this area. Brown goshawks also nest here and there are numerous ground-dwelling mammals living in this area - bandicoots, eastern swamp wallabies, echidnas and possums have all been seen in this bushland. All of these animals would be severely threatened by the clearing of this bushland.

I moved to this area because I liked the quiet suburb and the bushland out my back door, so I emphatically object to the approval of this development application. Thank you
