Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- Vegetation query - X type located in both A & C Wards;

Officer comments

Council's Natural Environment - Biodiversity section raises no objections to the proposed development.

This application was assessed against Warringah DCP E2 Prescribed impacts, E4 Wildlife Corridors, E6 Retaining unique environmental features.

The proposal is for the alterations and additions to the existing dwelling including a first floor addition and new swimming pool. No native trees or vegetation are to be impacted. The proposal complies with biodiversity controls.
