Reasons for referral

This application requires detailed consideration of Phase 1 and 2 contaminated land matters And as such, Council's Environmental Investigations officers are required to consider the likely impacts.

Officer comments General Comments

Proposal to demolish Long Reef Surf Life Saving Club and construct a new structure. Environmental Health have assessed the matter of fill material (possibly unsettled natural sands) below the existing structure.

Geotechnical report 2017-235 provided by Crozier Geotechnical Consultants provides some insight to the materials found below the surface of the existing structure. No indication that any of the material to be excavated is contaminated.

Waste Management report discussed that excavated material will be re-used on-site.

Conditions regarding compliance with the waste management plan are suffice assuming no removal of excavated material.

Recommendation

APPROVAL - subject to conditions
