HERITAGE COMMENTS

Discussion of reason for referral

This proposal has been referred to Heritage as the subject property is within the vicinity of a heritage item:

A2270488 - Stone Wall - Bungan Head Road, road reserve, adjacent to Betty Morrison Reserve, Newport.

Details of heritage items affected

Statement of Significance

The Stone Wall is an historic sandstone retaining wall erected in the 1920s reusing sandstone blocks that were part of the Goldsborough Mort building in Circular Quay and Customs Station wall in Palm Beach. The convict hewn stones are historically associated with the early inhabitants of Pittwater. It is an attractive addition to the landscape and a characteristic item of street construction and is evidence of previous road alignments. Part of the stone wall is collapsed creating a public safetv risk.

Physical Description

The Stone Wall extends approximately 800m and is approximately two metres high. The wall is comprised entirely of loosely packed sandstone.

Consideration of Application		

The application seeks consent for the demolition of the existing dwelling and associated structures, and the proposed subdivision of the existing allotment into two Torrens Title lots. The existing dwelling is a three-storey brick and stone residence with a detached metal carport. The heritage item is located directly south of the property across Bungan Head Road. Heritage raises no overall objection to the proposal but requires the following condition.

Construction Traffic Management Plan

The proposal is in close proximity to a heritage item. Given the proposal includes truck movements and works in close proximity to this item, Heritage will condition that detailed protection methods



and strategies for its protection during the demolition works be prepared and included in a construction traffic management plan.

Therefore, Heritage raises no objections subject to one condition
