Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- All Development Applications on
- Actual or potential threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats;
- Wildlife corridors;
- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query X type located in both A & C Wards;

And as such, Council's Natural Environment Unit officers are required to consider the likely potential environmental impacts.

Officer comments

The following biodiversity provisions apply to the site:

- Pittwater LEP Clause 7.6 (Biodiversity Protection)
- Pittwater DCP Clause B4.6 (Wildlife Corridors)
- SEPP (Coastal Management) Littoral Rainforest Proximity Area
- SEPP (Coastal Management) Coastal Environment Area

The proposed development is generally within the existing development footprint and is therefore unlikely to impact upon vegetation, biodiversity or coastal environmental values at the site. It is considered that the proposal complies with relevant controls.
