Thank you for your time on Friday re the discussion of the DA at 8 Bilkurra Ave, Bilgola.

It is refreshing to see that a new home will be built to replace the old home on the site. A new home will certainly add appeal to the site.

We are concerned with two aspects of the proposed build that being:

- 1. The shadowing of our home at 6 Bilkurra Ave due to the height of the proposed building. We presently enjoy the lovely sunshine on the home and yard and this will be significantly impacted by the height of the build as per the shadow diagram in the DA. As per our discussion, you mentioned that the DA fell within the guidelines and there was nothing we could do other than write to council outlining our concern. We do not want to interfere with our neighbours building their new home, rather we are writing to see what can be done to minimise the shadowing that will occur on our property. Can the roof height be altered etc to minimise shadowing?
- 2. The location of the air conditioning compressor unit is shown on the southern boundary of the DA. The new home will be built more closely to the southern boundary compared to the northern boundary which shows a greater setback of the home from the fenceline. Is it possible to re-locate the ai-conditioning compressor to the northern boundary to minimise its noise impact and have it further away from any adjoining property as a result?

Apart from the above two concerns, we welcome our neighbour's building what looks like a lovely new home.
