

THE WHOLE OF THE SITE IS TO BE MAINTAINED AS AN ASSET PROTECTION ZONE

The Asset Protection Zone is a buffer zone between a bush fire hazard and the dwelling. It is an area of reduced bush fire fuel. Fallen leaves, twigs and bark should not be allowed to build up, however a light cove over 90% of the ground should be retained to help prevent soil erosion. Encourage native ground covers such as maidenhair, kidney weed and the native grasses (from List 1.)
