Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- All Development Applications on

- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query X type located in both A & C Wards;

Delineation of the Asset Protection Zone

Prior to the commencement of any vegetation modification, the extent of the Asset Protection Zone must be marked with galvanized posts or similar.

The installation of these posts to delineate the extent of the Asset Protection Zone is permanent and is to be supervised by the Project Ecologist.

Details demonstrating compliance is to be submitted to the Principal Certifying Authority.



Reason: Bushland Protection (DACNEGOG1)

Asset Protection Zone - Bushland Management

APZ management works are to be undertaken by qualified and experienced bush regenerators.

No noxious or environmental weeds, as listed on Warringah Councils website are to be imported on to the site.

Noxious and environmental weeds are to be managed continuously, in accordance with the Noxious Weeds Act 1993 and the Bushland Management Plan, Greenhaven, R.S.L. Veterans Village, Collaroy Plateau 2002.

Details prepared by the project ecologist in writing demonstrating compliance is to be submitted to the Principal Certifying Authority.
