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#### Officer comments

The information supplied appears to only request consent for Demolition of the site. To that affect, Council's Traffic Team raise no objection to the CTMP subject to concurrence of RMS, as all access to and from the site is expected to occur from the state road.

Further, The use of the local roads; South Creek Road, Cumberland Ave and Westmoreland Ave, is deemed acceptable.

The applicant is proposing a Work Zone within a dedicated Bus Lane. This will require a Road Occupancy Licence from the Transport Management Center. This must then be submitted to Council as part of Work Zone Application and approved by Council prior to installation of the necessary signage.

The proposal is therefore supported.

## **DEFERRED COMMENCEMENT CONDITIONS**

### **RMS Approval - Construction Traffic Management Plan**

The applicant is to submit to, and have approved by RMS, the CTMP for the anticipated construction/demolition works. A copy of this approval is to be submitted to Council for concurrence prior to the consent becoming active.

Reason: To ensure RMS is satisfied with the works occurring from a State Road.(DACTRADC1)

### **Compliance with Standards**

The development is required to be carried out in accordance with all relevant Australian Standards.

## CONDITIONS THAT MUST BE ADDRESSED PRIOR TO ANY COMMENCEMENT

#### **Application for Permits**

The applicant is to obtain a road Occupancy Licence (ROL) from the traffic Management Center (TMC) and submit the ROL to Council as part of any Work Zone Application.

The Works Zone Application must be approved by Council prior to the associated works commencing.

Reason: To ensure necessary permits are in approved prior to corresponding works being carried out (DACTRDPC1)

### **State Transit Authority (STA) Concurrence**

Any works occurring from the Bus Lane fronting the subject site shall have concurrence from STA. A copy of the concurrence shall be submitted to Council as part of any and all permits for works to be undertaken in relation to the subject site. All permits are to be approved by Council prior to the associatedworks commencing.

Reason: To ensure minimal impact on the STA Bus Service (DACTRDPC2)
