COUNCIL DECISION


1. That Council note the contents of the report.

7.3 EXTENSIVE TREE FELLING AND CLEARING OPERATIONS WITHIN THE INGLESIDE/WARRIEWOOD LAND RELEASE STUDY AREA

COUNCIL DECISION

1. That the contents of this report be noted.
2. That Council prosecute significant breaches of the Tree Preservation Order, where environmental damage may be a consideration, through the Land and Environment Court with the approval of the Minister for the Environment and as part of such actions seek to have disturbed and cleared areas replanted and regenerated in accordance with a properly prepared rehabilitation plan.
3. That Council clearly advise members of the public and landowners within the Ingleside/Warriewood Land Release Study Area that the determination of land use classifications and future rezonings will be based on environmental characteristics of the area, including vegetation, which were in existence prior to January 1994 as determined by the Environmental Studies carried out by Council for the Ingleside/Warriewood Land Release Project.
