The proposed development mocks the heritage style of the existing building. Whilst is retains a relative outline, the characteristics of the building are lost entirely. The existing building is one of Sydney's Northern Beaches last standing French Colonial style 1600 - 1700's. A frame house, dormer house with chimney. The existing second storey presents a dormer, with a facade running to the edges of the roof framing, with a single small window peaking through, sitting above a living space. The proposed development presents a duplex, with split balconies above garages, with zero of the french colonial characteristics. The assessor is encouraged to view the existing house which boasts similarities against the

Furthermore, the existing development, a 5-bedroom house, offers a double car lockable garage with 3-4 additional site available parking within the driveway. Similar to the neighbours on the street.
