### Reasons for referral

This application seeks consent development on land, or within 40m of land, containing:

- All Development Applications on
- Actual or potential threatened species, populations, ecological communities, or their habitats;
- Wildlife corridors;
- Vegetation query stipulating that a Flora and Fauna Assessment is required;
- Vegetation query - X type located in both A & C Wards;

And as such, Council's Natural Environment Unit officers are required to consider the likely potential environmental impacts.

### Officer comments

The lot was created as part of an approved subdivision within the Warriewood Valley land release area. The site has been previously cleared and is not within or interface with the riparian zone or portion of the parent lot mapped as Biodiversity under the Pittwater LEP 2014. The development will not have a significant effect on biodiversity and therefore no further assessment is required.
