FISHERMANS WALK

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CONCEPT DESIGN FEATURES

- (1) Existing vehicle turn-around area to be retained
- (2) Coloured concrete threshold area (make good surrounding pavement as necessary)
- (3) Accessible parking spaces to be retained in their current location
- (4) Existing parking pay-station retained
- 5 Proposed FRP stairs & ramps (1:14 grade) 1.8m wide with side-mounted handrails/balustrades
- 6 Engineered retaining wall to tie into existing carpark retaining wall
- (7) Existing retaining walls to be retained
- 8 Sandstone block seat walling (450mm high)
- (9) Sandstone retaining edges (250mm high)
- (10) Proposed native feature planting to soften ramp structure
- (1) Concrete accessible ramps (1:14 & 1:20 grades)
- (12) Existing lawn, sandstone block seat wall & sewer infrastructure to be retained and protected
- (13) Batten screen under elevated structure
- (14) New widened entry to the swim club with the opportunity for seating
- (15) Retain existing coloured concrete ramp (& sandstone logs/edging) tying into existing upper levels
- (16) Existing stair access to rockpool
- (17) New stairs to connect to existing stairs and landings (make good concrete and handrails as necessary)



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
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CONCEPT DESIGN FEATURES

- 1 Proposed FRP boardwalk 1.8m wide providing safe, separated, accessible pedestrian access along the extent of the carpark
- Reconfigure parking to allow for new pathway connection. No loss of parking spaces
- 3 Embellish existing native shrub and groundcover planting
- 4 Low sandstone block wall to enable greater vehicular maneuverability space
- 5 Coloured concrete path extension to tie into existing levels allowing for a continuous accessible connection to Fishermans Walk
- 6 Retain existing entry features to Fishermans Walk
