Please visit this intersection during school drop off/pick up times to truly understand the impact of what is proposed. Traffic controllers will not alleviate the chaos.

Cooyong Road cannot sustain truck entry either. Currently trying to turn left or right into the site is precarious at best and presumably will only increase once Flower Power Warriewood closes.

Reading the Traffic Management plan on paper sound oh so logical and sensible, however having lived here for 16 years, my experience is that unless you haven't physically tried to negotiate these roads, every day, then you have no idea how this will impact our community.
