I strongly object to the DA2019/1234 by El Camino and Sake to extend the outdoor seating area of these two venues with a whopping 438 seats. Not only will this significantly change the character of the heritage wharf, but it will severely affect the ambience of Manly Cove. No one should be under any illusion that this extended space is intended to facilitate "fine dining". It's intended to increase drinking space, and with that comes a lot of noise. Crowd noise and bass noise from amplified music have been a significant problem in Manly Cove for many years now. The last thing we need is to add to this. It is a recipe for conflict.
