1. GRASS MANAGEMENT

The Drop Festival Site Management team will have adequate ground protection on site for the duration of the event for bump in, event and bump out phases. The ground protection will be located in key areas of high vehicle and pedestrian traffic and sensitive turf areas such as vehicle movements on the playing surfaces.


Trackmat can be used to create temporary roadways or loading pads as required. These resources will be portable and will be moved around site. This process will be managed by the site manager and site crew, who have extensive experience in producing major events in outdoor greenfield spaces, parklands and stadiums and understands the challenges these venues can present especially in adverse weather.

In addition to the ground protection provided for bump in and out, there will be event ground protection in high pedestrian traffic areas such as in front of the stage, bars and toilets. The extent of this flooring will be determined closer to the event based on weather and ground conditions.
