I have been teaching the art of Mosaics in a demountable classroom at the back of Flower Power nursery, Terrey Hills, since 2007 For the last 16 years, I have had the absolute pleasure of taking 2 classes per week, across 4 terms of every school year. Covid threatened to dismantle us, but we worked out how to still come together a group but in a safe environment at FP.

Many of my ladies have been with me since the very beginning, so it is not just an art class to learn a new skill. It is bringing a community together, one of friendship and companionship, its a counselling session, a shoulder to cry on, a forum to bounce ideas around, a safe place Its about Creativity but also its about Life.

My students come from far and wide and include the areas of Terrey Hills, Killara, Pymble, Dee Why, Mosman, Narabeen, Scotland Island, Davidson, Palm Beach, Newport, Allambie, St Ives, Killarney Heights and Belrose Whilst on the site, students will buy plants, homewares, coffee, lunch, furniture.

During the redevelopment of the nursery, I know that my classroom will be bulldozed completely.

I am unclear as to whether another teaching/community space is to be built Obviously I would like to see a space where I could continue my twice weekly classes but I fear that once the demolition occurs and we have a forced extended break, our groups of ladies from Garden Shed Mosaics will be dispersed permanently.

I guess Im asking for 2 things 1 is there any way a demountable classroom could be set up in the far corner of the carpark during demolition/construction, so our weekly classes can continue? I am under the impression that the site will remain open for trade, so remaining open for my classes would be wonderful!

2 will there be a new classroom located in the redevelopment that will serve as a creative/community space that I could use once the redevelopment has been completed? I really would hate to see our groups dispersed due to redevelopment and 'progress' It is a loss for all of us in the community.
