Officer comments

This DA seeks development consent for the demolition of a existing dwelling house, subdivision into two allotments, and construction of an attached dual occupany.

Council's Landscape section have assessed the application against the landscape controls of Manly DCP2013, section 3: General Principles of Development, and section 4: Development Controls and Development Types, including 4.1.1.2 Residential Land Subdivision, and 4.4.8 Subdivision. Subdivision

The proposal in terms of landscape outcome does not satisy 3.3.1 Landscaping Design, section b) ii) "Landscaped Areas must be capable of supporting new native tree species that are typically expected to reach a mature height of 10m notwithstanding the minimum dimension requirements at paragraph 4.1.5.2 of this plan".

The selected tree planting (Acmena smithii) as shown on the Landcsape Plan is located against the proposed garage> this may warrant a request for removal in the future, is unlikely to become established in this location, and hence unable to soften the built form.

The current layout within the front setback is unable to support tree planting, as insufficient ground area is available, and future impediments such as garage and building proximity will not allow tree canopy to develop to soften the built form.

The Landcsape Plan does not provide detailed information of proposed planting, with TBD (to be determined) noted for much of the planting layout.
