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Reasons for Refusal:

Trees 1-8 are located in the Pittwater Spotted Gum Forest EEC As the species to be removed are all native to NSW, the application needs to be referred to the NSW Native Vegetation Panel: <https://www.nvp.nsw.gov.au/>

The customer has been referred to the link as it was not evident upon inspection that the trees were dead or dying.

NOTE:

This determination is related to the condition of the tree/s at the time of inspection by Council and is limited to a visual assessment of the subject tree from ground level.

The responsibility of routine inspection and maintenance of trees located on private property is the responsibility of the relevant landowner.

Tree owners are strongly advised by Council to have their trees regularly inspected and maintained, to prevent the likelihood of branch or tree failure.

Right of Appeal

If you are dissatisfied with this decision Section 97 of the Environmental Planning & Assessment Act 1979 may give you the right to appeal to the Land and Environment Court within 3 months after the date on which you receive this notice.
