Details of heritage items affected

Statement of Significance

Palm Beach Kindergarten was built in 1958 to a design by Sydney architect Peter Muller, and has aesthetic and historic significance as an excellent example of Late Twentieth-Century Organic architecture. The building is an early example of Muller's work and shows the effect of the community on the provision of community facilities. Palm Beach Kindergarten retains a high level of intactness. It is also technically interesting for its attempt to adapt scale to the heights of its inhabitants, in this case children up to 5 years old.

One storey timber and concrete structure with brick cladding and slated sloping roof.

Consideration of Application

The proposal seeks consent for a new upper storey at the subject site. It will be located towards the lluka Road frontage of the site. The heritage item directly adjoins the site, however the significant building is located towards Barrenjoey Road and has been splayed to face both the main road and the park. While the new upper level will be noticeable from the kindergarten site, it is not considered to significantly impact upon the heritage building or its significance due to the physical setback between the upper level and the item, as well the landscaping in between.

Therefore Heritage raises no objections and requires no conditions.
