# Officer comments General Comments

Environmental Health has reviewed the Wastewater report from Enviro Engineers Australia dated 19 March 2021 and consider approval subject to attached conditions.

The proposal adds a pool and details of how the waste water from the pool will be managed.

The inground trampoline near the Land Application Area should not be allowed due to posing a serious health risk to the users of the equipment.

#### **Waste Water System**

Prior to the issuing of any interim / final occupation certificate, a copy of a s68 (Local Government Act 1993) approval to operate the Waste Water System, and the waste water system must be activated and effectively operating to the satisfaction of the Principal Certifying Authority.

Details demonstrating compliance are to be submitted to the Principal Certifying Authority.

Reason: To ensure the premises a maintained in an appropriate manner in perpetuity.

### Condition for prior to occupation certificate - Pool waste water

Details of the waste water disposal from the pool is to be submitted to Council identifying the system to control waste water from the pool.

Reason: To ensure waste water from the pool is disposed of correctly so as to not create water pollution or damage to vegetation

### ON-GOING CONDITIONS THAT MUST BE COMPLIED WITH AT ALL TIMES

On going condition - No inground trampoline within the waste water disposal area No inground trampoline is to be located within 6 metres of the grassed area used for the waste water disposal bed.

Reason: To avoid surfacing of waste water within the hole for the trampoline which would be a health issue with potential exposal of effluent and potential pest issues.
