As a long time resident I have observed over the past 20yrs the steady increase in traffic on this street obviously directly attributed to the rapid growth of housing and population density within the greater council area. Alexander street has by default turned into a major arterial road used to access Collaroy Plateau. We residents petitioned Council around 7 yrs ago regarding the traffic flow, pedestrian safety and resident amenity on the street. The resultant being two useless fake painted speed bumps and a couple of poorly placed no parking signs to no effect.
