I am the owner of 28 the Strand, Whale Beach. I understand the current modification being considered by council, is for an increase of 64 patrons to 170 Patrons in the newly proposed café (restaurant). I strongly object for a number of reasons.

- 1. This is an unusually large café/restaurant in a location that is really not serviced by an appropriate number of carparks and easy access. The potential for disruption and a somewhat chaotic environment is high
- 2. The additional noise increases and the resultant extra rubbish will overly disturb what is a relatively peaceful environment
- 3. The location won't support economically such an endeavour, we have repeatedly seen restaurants come & go and potentially what is left is a just an ugly void and long term an empty space.
- 4. The proposal goes well beyond what the locals require, and it is worth remembering that outside holiday peaks, the local population is not large.

I would urge council to reject this amendment and revert to the more sensible first proposal of a 64 patron space which is far more in tune the environment within which it will sit. Best
