Have just noticed Developement Application (DA2024/1733) 5 Roosevelt Ave , Allambie Heights on your website .

We are still to receive any formal notification of this DA . We are located directly adjoining block on lower side , 6 Monserra Rd Allambie Heights .

Owners of DA have been very open with there intent and have even supplied a copy of there plans.

Whilst we have no objection to the addition and pool we do have grave concerns with the Stormwater .

Applicants property currently releases its uncontrolled storm water to our property to which is just barely managed .

The proposed DA is to increase this flow to 100% of its stormwater onto our property via an onsite detention system with spreader .

Despite efforts to add 2 small detention tanks which are only as useful as there initial fill the system proposed simply doesn't work without flooding our block .

Geographically we are the lower water course of our neighbouring houses number 4 and 8 Monserra road. Both these properties have rock structures prominently out of ground with our rock course just below our grass level. needless to say what the results would be.

It is my professional opinion as a licenced Builder that the applicant needs to seek an alternative such as retention tank pumped to street .

Additionally we would like to request pool has an overflow pipe in filter box to help reduce any flooding during heavy rains .
