The sea wall is impacting on sand deposits which form surfing banks in the ocean. Extending the wall may make most of the beach unsurfable but also unsafe for swimmers due to backwash, less sandbanks so dangerous rips, etc.

The sea wall should only be limited to the properties at risk of imminent danger, the natural beach should be left everywhere else.

Sand movements from the lagoon should be prioritised for these areas to keep the beach as natural as possible
