I would like to petition council to remove the large fig trees on the southern edge of Florence Park. Over the years these trees have grown considerably and I believe now pose a hazard that warrants their removal.

1. The tree nearest the road constitutes a pedestrian hazard as the overgrown roots force walkers to travel on the road itself.
2. The extensive root network is likely to cause damage to the storm water system in place.
3. The trees further west are in poor condition, with significantly reduced foliage ever since the seawall was rebuilt.
4. There is no intrinsic merit to this species in this location as it is not native to the area.
5. The surrounding area has a very significant coverage of large trees such that the removal of the fig trees will not cause a meaningful loss of habitat.

I trust that you will consider this request with due care.
