Cricket NSW (CNSW) support MWDCC **DA2023/1237** submission for an Indoor Site at Cromer. The proposed scope of works include:

- **Indoor Centre** This indoor cricket facility will meet training needs for the vast cricket population throughout the northern beaches.
- Accessibility Facilities that meet and exceed universal design requirements by supporting access for people with disabilities.
- Essential storage to support the requirements of growing clubs.
- **Public Toilets** providing a safe and accessible amenity to support community use of the precinct.
- **Community and club space** dedicated club / social space together with flexible use, general community space.

In developing the *CNSW Infrastructure Strategy* [CNSWIS] (2020-2030), the Top 5 Infrastructure Priorities for the Northern Beaches area were identified as;

- **1.** Facilities to support the growth of female cricket Ensuring female cricketers have adequate access to facilities to support the growth in participation at all levels.
- 2. Improved access to facilities Work with other codes and LGAs to enhance cricket's access to existing facilities.
- **3.** Consistent levels of service Develop consistent guidelines for the level of service of community cricket facilities.
- **4. Renewal of ageing infrastructure -** Develop a priority list of facilities for upgrade or renewal of key infrastructure such as changerooms.
- 5. Cricket & Community Centres Cricket and Community Centres (Centres) has been identified is an infrastructure priority for CNSW. These Centres are to be located strategically to service the needs of both the performance pathway and community cricket at a regional level (ideally within a 1.5 2-hour drive time).



We recognise the need for an indoor training facility on the Northern Beaches. CNSW is in support of the submission for this facility by MWDCC.
