Discussion of reason for referral

This application has been referred as it is within the vicinity of a heritage conservation area, being *Item C5 Dee Why Lagoon and Reserve,* listed in Schedule 5 of Warringah Local Environmental Plan 2011.

Details of heritage items affected

Details of the heritage item in the vicinity are:

Item C5 Dee Why Lagoon and Reserve

Statement of Significance

The Australian Heritage Commission states in its official statement of significance that: 'Dee Why Lagoon is one of the best examples, in the Sydney Region, of an estuarine lagoon. It is one of the few large estuarine barrier lagoons, remaining in good condition, in the Sydney Region. The saltmarsh of the lagoon area is a regionally uncommon remnant of saline marshlands, which were formerly more widespread in the Sydney Region. The diversity of saltmarsh plants found at Dee Why Lagoon is high in comparison to other saltmarsh communities in the region. Dee Why Lagoon is also an important site for teaching and research associated with biological zonation, estuarine barrier lagoons and estuarine wetlands.'The Lagoon is also an important feeding and sheltering place for migratory birds, including some from the Northern Hemisphere.Its south-western sector also contains one of the best remaining stands of Swamp Mahogany (Eucalyptus robusta), now a threatened species.
