I currently live in Shackel Avenue Brookvale. To say this is a busy street is a massive understatement, cant wait to move its a nightmare.

The traffic at peak times is so bad – especially in the afternoons from 3pm to 5pm in particular and it is mostly traffic from St Augustines going up to Warringah Rd. The traffic is banked up down towards Brookvale oval, every school day there are near accidents, road rage, tooting, verbal abuse, brake squealing in near misses, constant, noticeably returned this week when school returned.

If you live in Shackel Avenue you cannot turn right from Victor Road from 7.30-9.30am and again from 3-6pm.
