The wave energy reflected from the wall will remove the sand as it travels back out to sea. This will reduce the amount of sand in front of the wall and therefore the beach usable to the public. The beach access from Stuart Street was closed for approximately one year during construction with a brief opening over Christmas, this isn't an acceptable solution.

The DA submitted is incomplete as there is no specification of the wall type proposed. Additionally, the level of community
