Dear Mr Ferguson

I am writing to you in regard to the above application which I understand Councils planning department is currently assessing

I would like to begin by indicating the community's disappointment in regards to the amendments to part 3 – Gateway determination, of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979, adopted by The Department of Planning on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2009 I understand that council is to submit to the department their 'planning proposal' to rezone, including justification of its merits prior to any public consultation I, and my fellow residents, am outraged at the new process, whereby residents input is only sought once a decision to proceed with the rezoning has been made I would like to ask how the Department can make such a decision with only comment from one party The Council may very well have different views on the merits of an application than the affected residents.

Therefore, I ask that you take into consideration the points outlined below when considering this proposal

The planning and current development by Pittwater Council in the way of parkland, bushland, walking/cycle tracks and wetlands area is very much in accordance of the lifestyle envisioned by myself and those considering purchasing property in the expanding residential area of Warriewood Valley The Ingleside/Warriewood Urban Land Release Study, that begun some 20 years ago in my opinion up to date has enhanced the area and made it a pleasant place to live

The vicinity around the intersection of Garden and Macpherson Streets, within the valley planning was originally identified to be the site for a focal neighbourhood centre – this was explained to Pittwater residents as a community centre. When the master plan for Section 8 was adopted, it was then identified that this space may accommodate a SMALL neighbourhood centre in the form of a corner store and possibly a few other shops along with some residential. This is the premise that the developers advertised and sold there developments, and the new residents of Warriewood Valley decided to purchase their properties.

The planned 1171m2 neighbourhood centre will adequately meet the needs of the local community but not the 3950m2 retail space that is currently under consideration. The Warriewood community already has a very large shopping

complex with two supermarkets to cater to all our needs without being subjected to another right in our backyard

It is a ridicules statement that the larger proposal will be limited to serving the daily shopping needs of residents in the release area. How do you propose to enforce it to only residents in the release area?? This centre will be available to all only increasing our concern for increased traffic, noise and loss of amenity.

#### **1** Traffic Impact

I am concerned that the proposal will increase traffic flow enormously in and out of Warriewood Valley where the existing road system of two lanes is not adequate to support this increase

It is noted that we currently have a 3 tonne vehicle limit within the area of the 3950m2 planned proposal and this will have to be lifted to allow the semi trailers deliveries that will be required to service a supermarket the size of 3200m2

#### 2. Safety Issue

Safety to residents, school children and the elderly in particular from the Anglican Retirement Village will be of grave concern due to the increase of traffic and the excess heavy vehicles travelling into and out of Warriewood Valley

The creek line corridors of our area which house a menagerie of wild life will become endangered in their environment I was made aware of this fact when local traffic was stopped on Macpherson St, Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2009 to allow two ducks and their family of 8 ducklings to navigate safely across the road

#### Conclusion

To date Pittwater Council has done a wonderful job with the development of Warriewood Valley, please don't let developers destroy our environment and lifestyle

I strongly urge Pittwater Council and Councillors to reject this proposal in the interest of our community
