Officer comments General Comments

This application is seeking consent for change of use to a gym (known as Rumble) with associated fitout and signage at office No.4, 4-10 Inman Road, Cromer.

The proposed gymnasium will operate Monday to Sunday 5:00am to 7:30pm with 45-minute group fitness classes. At any one time, there will be 1 staff member operating the reception desk and performing administrative tasks, and 1 staff member instructing the class with a maximum of 28 participants per class.

There is no excavation of the ground level therefore contaminated lands will not be affected through this development.

Environmental Health supports this approval.

The proposal is therefore supported.
